We all need dreams to <u>engage</u> in our life.


We all need <u>**God**</u> to guide those dreams instead of us.

Dream: a cherished aspiration, ambition, or ideal.

God dream: a calling involving purpose that prompted outside of personal ambition.

Prophetic dream: term usually used to reference dreams of foresight from God about future events or dreams that contain supernatural messages.





- We must **anchor** our dreams in Christ.
- We must view trusting His <u>omniscience</u> about our dream as critical.
- We can't love our dream <u>so much</u> that it becomes a god.
- Remember, dreams in scripture were kingdom focused.


Christ calls Himself a Door in John 10:9.
